

Once a flourishing commercial town Mozia was completely destroyed in the 4th century BC the site, and forgotten for centuries, until Joseph Whitaker, a Sicilian-English ornithologist and exporter of Marsala wine, started digging enthusiastically, allowing the rediscovery of Mozia's past, and the creation of the Whitaker museum, an extensive collection of archaeological remnants.



SYRACUSE AND NOTO

Savor the ride and the views traveling to Syracuse, an icon of timeless Sicilian beauty. Follow your guide learning about the city's history and bewitching legends. Built on an ancient Greek settlement in 734 BC (BCE), Syracuse was the largest city in the ancient world. Take a voyage into the past visiting the city's extensive archeological site, a rare treasure chest of temples and amphitheaters. Discover the exquisite island of Ortygia, located across the water from the mainland, an enchanting eclectic maze of ancient medieval alleys. After exploring Syracuse travel inland to Noto, and discover the town's hypnotically gorgeous historic center, an archetype of baroque architecture. Completely destroyed by a devastating earthquake in 1693 it was rebuilt by three architects, Labisi, Sinatra and Gagliardi, who decided to create a town built according to baroque ideals: a perfectly proportioned urban center divided into three parts by three roads running east to west, so as to be always exposed to the sunlight. Follow your guide and see how the main building material used, local limestone, soaks sunrays in turning them into a soft honey-golden light. Stroll down the town's lovely main road, Corso Vittorio Emanuele, lined by superb baroque palaces, public gardens and main landmarks such as the Santissimo Salvatore Monastery, Palazzo Ducrezio and the Church of San Francesco. Stop at the splendid Cathedral for a visit. Standing on top of a monumental staircase it boasts a lovely façade with baroque motifs and houses the silver urn of San Corrado, the city's patron saint.

Rising on the edge of a canyon among stark mountains the site dates back to the 5th century BC and, nowadays, comprises the ruins of a stunning roofless Doric Temple built by the Elymians and an awe-inspiring semicircular theatre. Set in an outstanding position, perched high atop a hill at 400 mt. above sea level, the temple, and views from it, are simply sensational.
