
THE EGYPTIAN MUSEUM

Journey through antiquity, immerse yourself in fascinating history of ancient Egypt visiting Turin's extraordinary Egyptian Museum escorted by an expert guide! Housed in the austere Palazzo dell'Accademia delle Scienze Turin's is the world's most ancient Egyptian museum and comprises the most important, and impressive, collection of Egyptian artifacts and statues outside Cairo. The origins of the museum date back to 1630, when Charles Emmanuel I Duke of Savoy, started collecting Egyptian antiquities. The collection expanded over the years, especially thanks to the 18th century archaeological expeditions and acquisitions, and today counts over 6.500 objects, including sculptures, statuettes, architectural elements and decorations, sarcophagi, vases, everyday objects and tools, mummies, votive and religious objects, arms, toys, furniture, clothes and textiles, and an amazing collection of papyri. Follow your guide's lead through the vast display, extensively restored and refurbished in 2015, and splendidly arranged organized in chronological and thematic order, and lose yourself in the marvels of ancient Egypt admiring the awe-inspiring statue of Ramses II and the domestic items from the tomb of royal architect Kha and his wife Merit, dating back to 1400 BC!
