A VOYAGE INTO THE PAST

THE VENICE JEWISH GHETTO

Take a journey into the past, dive into Venice's history and traditional heritage and discover one of the most fascinating and evocative area in the whole of Venice, the Jewish ghetto, a neighborhood, which has given birth to a world-renowned word. The English word "ghetto", in fact, comes from here: the area had been used as a foundry, "geto" in Venetian dialect, hence "ghetto". Founded in 1516 this is the most ancient ghetto in the world, the first place where people were forcibly segregated because of their religion. Journey back in time and through the centuries visiting this superbly charming area, so rich in history and life and character, with the privilege of of a private tour led by an experienced English-speaking dedicated guide. During the visit you will hear all about the area's history and heritage, learning that the area was once inhabited by almost 5,000 Jewish people, subject to the rules of the Venetian Republic but free to profess their faith in the 5 synagogues still in existence today. Later, with the opening of the gates that once isolated them from the rest of the city in the 19th century, most of the Jews moved out of the Ghetto and today only few families still live there. The district has, however, not lost its identity at all: the neighborhood is lively and charming, and the VenetianJewish lifestyle thrives on. Your visit will include a guided promenade through the most scenic picturesque streets - lined by shops, artisan workshops and attractive typical restaurants – and exquisite squares where time seems to have stopped, and a visit to the Synagogues. Built on the top floor of the buildings in the Ghetto Novo these are hard to be seen and recognized from outside, but inside they are unrivalled gems. During the tour stop at the best typical bakery for a sweet taste of authentic Jewish-Venetian fare.

As the legend goes ago the handmade lace craft started when the village girls tried to imitate a mermaid's wedding veil, made of elaborately patterned sea spray! Follow your guide along the canals and through the pretty streets lined by rainbow-hued homes, see how lace in every shape and size floats from the tiny shops, catch unexpected views of eternity and breathe in its authentic atmosphere. After the visit travel on to fascinating Murano, kingdom of world-acclaimed of gorgeous handcrafted glass. Founded between the 5th and the 7th century Murano experienced its major development after 1291, when all Venetian glass furnaces were moved here to avoid fires in the main city. From then on the island became Europe's first supplier for high quality glass, and still today artistic and industrial fornaci (i.e. furnaces) continue to make superb glass products ranging from beads and mosaic tiles to elaborate chandeliers and works of art. Roam the picturesque streets, admire splendid ancient churches and crown your day with a visit to a traditional glass factory, and an unforgettable firsthand experience: a live glass blowing demonstration!

MASK PAINTING

Why does one always feels "watched" while walking through Venice's picturesque streets? It's the gleaming masks, peering out from shop windows, beckoning to you! Venetian masks are a centuries-old tradition, and an icon of the city. Experience the city's traditional heritage firsthand, dive into the glittering realm of Venetian masks! Visit an ancient mask workshop, famed worldwide, and master the art of creating your own Venetian mask hands-on, led by a pro a skilled Venetian artisan! Meet the in-house staff and take a look at the workshop's immense collection of custom-made papier-mache hand-crafted masks, each a unique piece which expresses the style and feelings of the artist who created it. Learn about the mask wearing tradition in Venice, the styles and types, and about the timehonored production techniques and variety of materials used for decoration: these also include precious ones, such as fine fabrics, real feathers, Swarovski gems, and gold or silver leaf. Then follow the expert guidance of your dedicated craftsman to create your own mask! Choose your preference among 60 types of Venetian masks, all in hand-made papier mache, and let your teacher lead you through the various phases of the decoration process and decorate two authentic Venetian masks. Dress your masks up with the traditional materials: acrylic tempura paint, natural wax and stunning metallic hues like gold, silver or copper. Once the mask is painted you can add charming additional decorative items such as rhinestones, feathers (and more!) and, at the very end, choose the ribbons you like best to add onto your, lovely, finished masterpiece. Your splendid hand-made Venetian masks will be dry and ready to be wrapped and taken off with you at the end of the activity... unique souvenirs of a memorable day to show your friends, and wear, once back home!
