A WALK IN BOLOGNA: HISTORY, FLAVORS AND AROMAS

Capital of Emilia-Romagna Bologna is also the kingdom of gastronomic delight; just think Parmesan cheese, balsamic vinegar, lasagna, tortellini and Parma ham all come from here! Stroll down the fine colonnade lined-streets, discover the city's charmand grandeur admiring the airy squares, such as grand Piazza Maggiore with the city hall, and evocative palaces and churches such as the Sala Borsa, Basilica di San Petronio and Basilica di Santo Stefano, and get ready to be surprised by the city's luscious typical specialties and most iconic sight, the fascinating leaning towers Torre Garisenda and Torre degli Asinelli! Namely "Home of the Stone Carpets" this amazing treasure chest of ancient beauty was discovered when skilled archaeologists found 14 rooms and 3 courtyards inside a small Byzantine palace. Just imagine their awe, when they saw that the floor surface of every single room was covered with marble inlay or mosaics displaying gleaming multi-colored patterns and figures!

Meet the friendly in-house staff, get under the labels and into the bottles of this precious delicacy exploring the must decanting room and aging area. Savor the rich aromas of different types of balsamic (including a 100 years old one!) directly from the wood barrels, and end your experience with a memorable lunch featuring luscious typical products, including balsamic served with Parmesan cheese, premium local cured meats, and bubbly ruby-red Lambrusco, one of the oldest wines in the world.
