CINQUE TERRE WINE TOUR

DISCOVERING GENOA

Step off the beaten track, spend an unusual half day exploring Genoa! World famous birthplace of Christopher Columbus and pesto, and Italy's largest sea port, this unique city lies somewhat off the tourist radar, offering the chance to experience real authentic Italian lifestyle and tradition. Discover this vast sprawling city's history, diversity, architectural magnificence and luxurious aristocratic palaces led by a knowledgeable local private guide, learn all about its eventful history. Called "La Superba", i.e. "the haughty" by the great poet Petrarca, Genoa was one of Italy's maritime republics (together with Venice, Amalfi and Pisa) that enjoyed enormous power and prestige in the Middle Ages and Renaissance. Unveil its charm following your guide through the narrow mysterious historic center's streets ("caruggi"), admire the impressive fortified walls, the longest defensive city walls in Italy, and the striking "vertical" way the whole town climbs up the hill. Discover the fascinating ancient port and the splendid Strade Nuove built by the most powerful Genoese families to show off their prestige during the city's Golden Age and lined by a magnificent sequel of sumptuous late-Renaissance and Baroque buildings. Just think: the neighborhood boasts 120 historical palaces, many of which feature spectacular staircases, courtyards and loggias overlooking gardens! Journey back in time visiting one of the most remarkable examples of this centuries-old grandeur, follow your guide through the striking halls and salons and learn all about the lavish feasts once held within these ancient walls.

See the nearby evocative 16th century watch tower and a replica of the famed Christ of the Abyss, a bronze statue which lies offshore at about 15mt under the sea, housed in the church next to the monastery.

THE ULTIMATE CINQUE TERRE EXPERIENCE

A fairytale-like destination where land and sea meet and authentic flavors, aromas and traditions live on. Spend an unforgettable day exploring one of the world's most spectacular coastal areas, the famed Cinque Terre, unveil the area's secrets, history and traditional legacy traveling comfortably by train led by the charisma and knowledge of your private guide. Set amid some of the most dramatic coastal scenery on the planet le Cinque Terre, five ingeniously constructed fishing villages, are a Unesco World Heritage site since 1997, and still today look very much like a version of a seafront garden of Eden. Sinuous paths run across stunning cliffs, and a 19th-century railway line cut through a series of coastal tunnels ferries the footsore from village to village. Learn all about the Cinque Terre's unique feature from your guide: the steeply terraced cliffs bisected by a complicated system of fields and gardens hacked, chiseled, shaped and layered over the course of nearly two millennia. So marked are these artificial contours that some scholars have compared the extensive "muretti" (low stone walls) to the Great Wall of China! And all enhanced by the charming villages - Riomaggiore, founded in the 8th century by Greek settlers fleeing persecution in Byzantium, Vernazza, Corniglia, Manarola and Monterosso - which look onto the gleaming pristine waters of the sea. Lose yourself in the gorgeous scenery, explore a few of the fascinating villages and treat yourself to a memorable typical Ligurian lunch (and exquisite regional wines!) in a lovely restaurant. Escape the maddening crowds, roam the coast, discover paradise on earth in le Cinque Terre!
