


Eremo della Giubiliana



Eremo della Giubiliana is a luxury hotel set within a historic 11th-century fortified estate, located on the Hyblaeen plateau just a few kilometers from Ragusa. Originally a convent for the Knights of the Order of Saint John, the property preserves the authentic charm of its thick white stone walls and the atmosphere of a spiritual retreat. Surrounded by centuries-old carob trees and traditional dry-stone walls, the Eremo overlooks a landscape that extends to the Mediterranean coast and the island of Malta, offering a unique historic residence.

ROOMS

The hotel features historical accommodations and independent stone cottages, each blending antique atmosphere with refined comfort:

Classic & Superior Rooms: Located in the ancient friars' cells, featuring original stone walls and traditional furnishings.

Deluxe Rooms: Spacious and elegant rooms with refined Sicilian antiques and views of the internal courtyards.

Junior Suites & Suites: Prestigious quarters with high ceilings, separate living areas, and historical charm.

Garden Cottages: Independent stone dwellings set among carob trees, offering maximum privacy and a rural-chic feel.

The Villa: A private and exclusive residence within the estate, featuring wide spaces and dedicated amenities for families or groups.

AMENITIES

Eremo della Giubiliana offers unique services that celebrate the heritage and nature of South-Eastern Sicily:

Asphodelus SPA: A wellness retreat offering Mediterranean aromatherapy, a Turkish bath, and treatments inspired by the estate's flora.
